In the heart of North Raleigh there is a place that is a home for hundreds of immigrants and refugees from all over the world. People from the Congo, Rwanda, Somalia, Afghanistan, Iraq, Syria, Vietnam and other countries are settled at Cedar Point Apartments on Sandy Forks Road.

Several local and international agencies like US Committee For Refugees and Immigrants, World Relief Durham and Lutheran Services Carolinas use Cedar Point to house these immigrant families.



## THE OPPORTUNITY

The existing education building at Cedar Point is not sufficient for the programs and activities needed to serve this population. We have received preliminary approval from the owner of Cedar Point to expand the existing Education Building. The expansion would be used for childrens' after school programs, classes to learn the English language, medical, education support and activities to help the immigrant population become acclimated into our culture and become productive members of the community.
